Lost in the Stars Dec 01 2020 The occupation of "lyricist" may not always be taken seriously. However, I saw this as an opportunity to carve a niche for myself in the otherwise crowded music industry. Lyric writing can be an intensely frustrating process as well as one of the most pleasurable and rewarding art forms. Far from professing to be an expert in this, I find deconstructing songs that I revere allows for a better understanding of my craft. Every word and syllable must justify its place within the lyric. The sound the words make (by means of alliteration, assonance, and perfect rhymes) must be pleasing to the ear. The form must contain innovative and concise thoughts within the repeated pattern of the song's structure. I seem to be seemingly endless rewrites until you cannot improve on it further. However, none of that matters if the listener cannot connect and empathise with the lyric's story or its theme. When all these pieces fit together, you pray the whole thing is "singable". Imagine a thousand jigsaw puzzle with only a blurred image on the cover of the box. The lyrics I am sharing with you all have one common feature; the all-consuming passion, dedication, and bloody-minded stubbornness I have needed to create them. These qualities are almost mandatory in my professional life as a dentist. Dentistry and lyric writing require a similar appreciation of the minutiae of their craft, striving for perfection in an almost microscopic world, even though the results in either may not always be obvious to the untrained eye (or ear). These words were written with the intention they would eventually find their musical soulmates, sing into the sunset to enjoy a long and prosperous lifetime together, rather than being abandoned on some forgotten corner of the poetry section at the local library. I hope whoever reads this book, takes pleasure from my lyrics. I would urge you to read all the lyrics for their individuality- if not always in subject matter, at least in how the sentiment has been expressed.
