health organization who defines an adolescent as any person between ages 10 and 19 this age range falls within who's definition of young people which refers to individuals between ages 10 and 24 web 28 apr 2023 key facts over 1.5 million adolescents and young adults aged 10-24 years died in 2020 nearly 5000 every day young adolescents aged 10-14 years have the lowest risk of death of all age groups injuries including road traffic injuries and drowning violence self harm and maternal conditions are the leading causes of death among web adolescence is the period of transition between childhood and adulthood children entering adolescence are going through many changes in their bodies and brains these include physical intellectual psychological and social challenges as well as development of their own moral compass web the process of adolescent physical growth begins and ends earlier for girls than for boys because of the dramatic hormonal physical and emotional changes that occur during adolescence
